### Entrees (Choose at least one.)

- ☐ **Bumper Cars Burgers:** Put each word into groups (3 to 5 groups), all of the words should relate except for one. You bump that word to the next word group. It's a chain effect.
- ☐ **Fettuccini Alfredo Ad:** Write an ad for your favorite food, car, toy, or restaurant using 5 of your vocabulary words. The ad should have headline or slogan, picture, and 3-6 sentences explaining the benefits of the product. Make it neat, colorful, and creative!
